This training will be a mixture of teaching and active practical exercises exploring the use of outcome measures in Dramatherapy in a variety of settings and with a range of client populations. We will consider the role of Outcome Measures in contributing to effective practice and how best to select, implement and eventually disseminate outcome information with patients, service leads, commissioners and within our own profession.

Participants will be introduced to a range of measures and begin to consider which measures might best suit their current and future practice. The training aims to be a stimulating and enjoyable look at our how we can continue to understand and improve our practice. In addition, participants will leave with a resource pack of OMs and a reading list identifying future online learning sources to continue developing skills in utilising Outcome Measures.

Aims of the workshop:

- To understand how to use outcome measures in everyday Dramatherapy Practice.
- To develop skills in selecting and implementing appropriate measures.
- To understand how to communicate and disseminate outcome information.
- To understand how outcome measure can support safe and effective practice.

She is a clinical supervisor, trainer and has lectured and presented for Arts Therapies Courses and conferences and is Training Lead in Mentalisation Based Treatments for children, young people and families and the Anna Freud National Centre for Children and Families.
